This **TRIP LIST** is designed for potential participants interested in VENT tours to **SOUTHERN MANITOBA** and/or **CHURCHILL** led by Jeri M. Langham. It includes all 391 species that have been accepted by the Manitoba Ornithological Records Committee for the entire Manitoba Province as of 2009 (most recently published list). The order of families and common names are those given by the American Ornithologists' Union *Check-list of North American Birds*, 7th edition and incorporates changes through the 49th Supplement. Species with an asterisk (*) preceding their name, need written descriptions and/or photographs submitted to Rudolf Koes, 135 Rossmere Crescent, Winnipeg, MB R2K 0G1.

For twenty-three years (until 2009), this was a single tour. When the VIA Rail train from Thompson to Churchill became unreliable (7 hours late in 2008) due to problems with the tracks, Victor decided to cancel the Thompson visit and train ride from Thompson to Churchill (the train we would have been on was turned back) and divide the tour into two tours that can be taken separately or together. Some of you might sign up for only one of these and some for both. If you only sign up for one of them, this list should help you see what you will be missing by not doing both. *It is important to mention that Ross's Gull is no longer reliable at Churchill as it was for many decades. However, there is so much more to see and experience in this unique habitat where tundra and taiga meet along Hudson Bay.*

Before signing up for a tour, many participants like to know their chances of seeing certain birds. The column labeled "**Both Tours**" indicates the *species seen (x) or only heard (h) in 2009 by those participants who were on both tours*. The column labeled "**All 24 Years**" indicates how many of my **TWENTY-FOUR** tours have seen or just heard each species. If there are two numbers, the first is tours on which it was seen and the second, tours on which it was only heard. This provides you with a very realistic idea of your chances of seeing your most wanted Manitoba birds if you take **BOTH** tours.

The column labeled "**S. Manitoba**" indicates those species seen (x) or only heard (h) on the 2009 SOUTHERN MANITOBA TOUR. We were almost completely rained out of the one-day in SW Manitoba so missed about 10 normally seen species. The column labeled "**Churchill**" indicates those species seen (x) or only heard (h) on the 2009 CHURCHILL TOUR. Winter was so late in 2009, that half the roads were inaccessible to birders during the time we were there due to snowdrifts and/or flooding. For my first time ever, the ice never melted at the Churchill River Mouth, so it was a very unusual year. This was the only tour of my 24 in which I could never get to Twin Lakes or out to Cape Merry and yet we did extremely well. I have only been keeping records for mammals during the last eighteen years; therefore, on page 10, the third column labeled "**Last 18 Years**" indicates how many of our last EIGHTEEN tours have seen each mammal species.

Those of you with little vacation time each year can take these tours on separate years and those with more time can combine them for a tremendous adventure seeing breeding birds and many species of mammals as spring bursts forth around you.
