**CUZCO, OLLANTAYTAMBO & MACHU PICCHU
BIRDING & CULTURE TOUR**

February 28:

After picking up the group at the airport in Cuzco, we visited a small lagoon called Huasao (before visiting Huacarpay Lagoon). There were many birds in both places. In late afternoon we arrived at Pakaritampu hotel in Ollantaytambo.

February 29:

After an early morning breakfast, we went to Abra Malaga Pass. The weather was good and we saw a lot of birds at both sites of the Malaga Pass. The White-tufted Sunbeam (hummingbird) and the Chestnut-breasted Mountain-Finch were highlights.

March 1:

We took the train heading to Aguas Calientes and visited the impressive Inca site of Machu Picchu. The weather was very good, and we walked extensively around the ruins. We saw the endemic Inca Wren, and in late afternoon we returned to Aguas Calientes to stay in the Machu Picchu Pueblo Hotel.

March 2:

After breakfast we walked part of the road looking for mixed species flocks, Torrent Ducks, and dippers. We saw many birds, including some dippers, but we did not see many ducks because the river level was really high.

March 3:

We spent the morning at the hotel. Two participants and I went to find mixed species flocks along the trails at the hotel. The best bird was the Black-and-chestnut Eagle in flight. In the afternoon we took the train back to Ollantaytambo, and we went back to Cuzco City by car.

March 4:

This morning we took a city tour (the main cathedral of Cuzco, and the famous Inca temple Koricancha). We had lunch at the Tunupa restaurant near the main square before departing for Lima and flights home.

I hope you enjoyed Peru and Cuzco. I am sure you will have good memories about my country!
