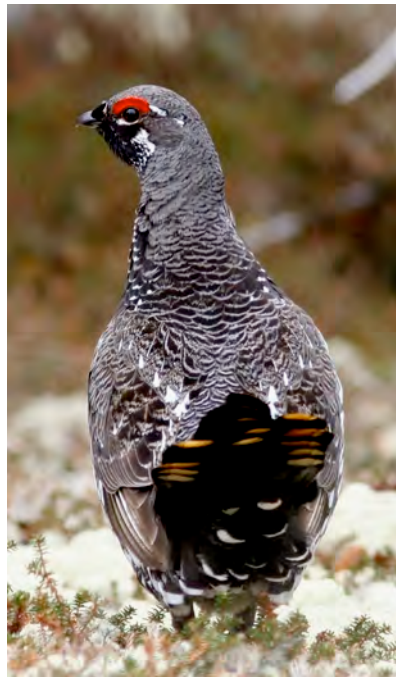

This **CHURCHILL & SOUTHERN MANITOBA TRIP LIST** is designed for VENT tours to Southern Manitoba, Thompson & Churchill led by Jeri M. Langham. It includes all 382 species that have been accepted by the Manitoba Ornithological Records Committee for the entire Manitoba Province as of 2001 (most recently published list). The order of families and common names in my Trip List are those given by the American Ornithologists' Union *Check-list of North American Birds*, 7th edition and incorporates changes through the 47th Supplement. My mammal list can be seen on page 10. Species with an asterisk (*) preceding their name, need written descriptions and/or photographs submitted to Rudolf Koes, 135 Rossmere Crescent, Winnipeg, MB R2K 0G1.

Before signing up for a tour, many participants like to know their chances of seeing certain birds. **Column I** indicates the species seen (x) or only heard (h) in 2007. **Column II** indicates how many of my **TWENTY-TWO previous tours** have seen each species. This number provides a very realistic idea of your chances of seeing your most wanted Manitoba birds. We have only been keeping records for mammals during the last sixteen years; therefore, column II on page 10 indicates how many of our **SIXTEEN** previous tours have seen each mammal species.

Be sure to look at the last page to see photographs taken by participants on the 2007 tour.

Sometime after you sign up for **CHURCHILL & SOUTHERN MANITOBA**, I will mail you the official, bound Checklist (with sixteen additional columns per page) that we will use each evening to keep records of what we have observed.

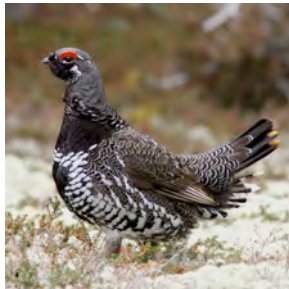

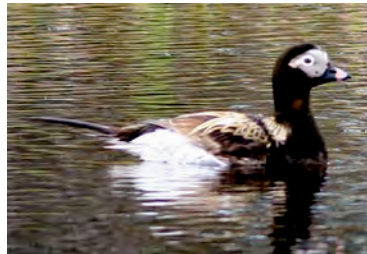

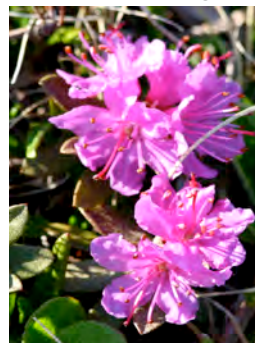
