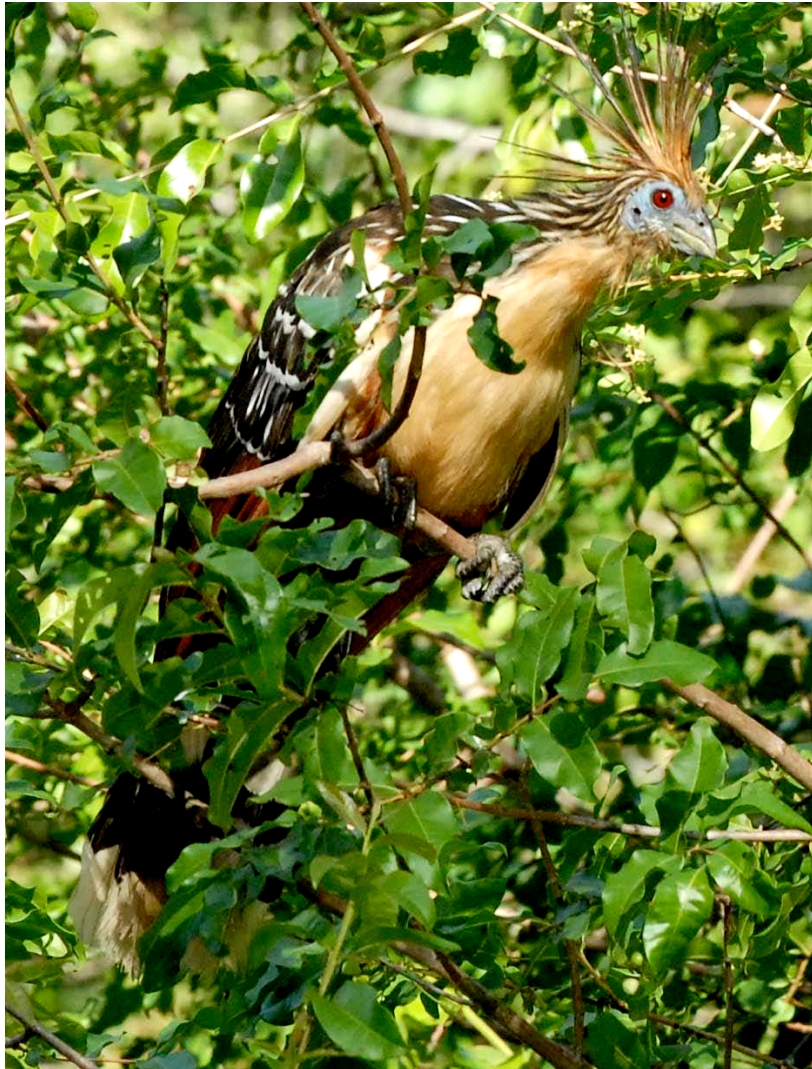

This TRIP LIST is for potential participants in VENT's **HATO PIÑERO NEW YEAR** tour led by Jeri Langham and co-led by David Ascanio, Gary Langham or Shawn Hayes. It includes species seen on past visits by **all** VENT personnel, whether as part of a tour or just a scouting trip. It also represents visits to **all** parts of the ranch during **all** seasons of the year.

Column I is designed to let you know which species are very common on the ranch and/or are good ones to learn as an example of different families. For those of you with limited time and/or little Neotropical experience, studying those species highlighted with an asterisk will help you prepare for our trip.

Column II is designed to give you a **realistic** idea of which species we are likely to encounter during our tour. A "blank", "1", "2", through "21" indicate the number of Jeri's **TWENTY-ONE** previous Hato Piñero New Year tours that have seen each species. An "h" indicates that the species was only heard. If there are two numbers separated by a comma, the first number indicates the number of tours on which it was seen and the second number the tours on which it was only heard.

Column III shows the species that were seen or heard on the most recent tour.

Hato Piñero New Year is a great tour for photography. After the tour, I always put together a page with representative photos taken that year by my participants. Be sure to scroll all the way to the last two pages of this Trip List to see some of the wonderful photos taken this year by Dave Drake and Daphne Gemmill.
